Jenna provided details on the 2022 Cookie Stroll. Overall, the event was well received by both customers and participating merchants. Many businesses commented that they had a lot of new people discover their businesses during this promotion. The Board discussed adding to the 100 cookie tins sold last year.

The Board directed staff to bring a proposed budget for FYE 2023 to the next PSD Board Meeting.

6. Reports

A. PSD Financial Report

The current financial report was included in the packet. There were no questions.

B. Events & Marketing

Jenna reported that Deck Art Registration is now open. Interested parties can register at South Street. Foodie February is also underway, with social media posts in support of the promotion running daily. New this year is the ability to text photos of receipts via the new Downtown Dish texting platform.

Taylor shared that the Farmers' Market Planning is well underway, with applications going out to vendors this month. Marketing Kits have also been distributed and work is beginning on the Spring/Summer Edition of the In Town Magazine.

Kristi shared that Rochester received its 17th consecutive Annual Accreditation as National Main Street Community. Additionally, Jenna and Kristi will be presenting at the annual Main Street Now Conference in Richmond, Virginia in May. The topic

SUBJECT: Request for Recommendation – Sidewalk Sales

We respectfully request your recommendation to City Council for approval of the 2022 Sidewalk Sales. The dates of the event are Thursday, July 14 and Friday, July 15 from 10:00 am – 9:00 pm, and Saturday, July 16 from 10:00 am – 6:00 pm. Chief Financial Credit Union has agreed to be the sole presenting sponsor of Sidewalk Sales for \$5,000. Sponsorships will aid in booking family friendly entertainment over the three-day period.

As in the past, merchants must reserve or decline the use of space in front of their stores and participating businesses are responsible for renting their own tents, table, etc. A copy of the Sidewalk Sale Policy will be distributed to each merchant reminding them that they cannot authorize other entities or organizations to use the sidewalk in front of their business. However, as space is available, we will allow use by side street businesses or non-profit organizations.

We will need assistance from DPW for trash pick-ups and some setup. Separate communication will be made with DPW and the Police Department to coordinate all details prior to the events.
