Halloween Fest!

We respectfully request your recommendation to City Council for approval of Trick-or-Treat Downtown, Costume Parade and Halloween Fest. This event will be held on Saturday, October 15 from 3:30 – 6:30 pm.

The event schedule is as follows:

3:30 – 5:00 pm Trick-or-Treat Downtown

5:15 – 5:45 pm Costume Parade 5:00 – 6:30 pm Halloween Fest

Halloween Fest will begin at 5:00 pm in the Farmers Market lot, corner of E. Third and Water. Activities include Halloween themed games and prizes, Ecto 1 and The Metro Detroit Ghostbusters, and The Linda Rea Team's pumpkin patch and more.

Set up for Halloween Fest will begin following the close of the farmers' market. We would like to close Water Street (between University and Third) and Third Street (between East and Second) to traffic from 5:00-6:30 pm for the costume parade and Halloween Fest. We also request closure of the Elevator lot at the corner of Water and University to use as a staging area before the parade at 5:15pm.

Separate communication will be made with DPW, Police and Fire Departments to coordinate all details prior to the event.

SUBJECT: Request for Recommendation - 2022 Kris Kringle Market

We respectfully request your recommendation to City Council for approval of the 2022 Kris Kringle Market event. The dates of the event are Friday, December 2 from 4-10 pm and Saturday, December 3 from Noon-10 pm. The event will be located on W. Fourth Street between Main Street and Walnut Blvd.

We request that W. Fourth Street be closed between Main and Walnut on Thursday, December 1. Please note that the section requested for road closure on W. Fourth includes the West Alley closure. As always, we expect large crowds and may request an additional police presence. Also, we will need assistance from DPW for trash pick-ups and setup assistance. Separate communication will be made with DPW and the Police Department to coordinate all details prior to the events.

Individual 10'  $\times$  10' or 10'  $\times$  20' tents will be set up for vendors to sell their wares, including food & beverage booths. We will be working with the Police Department to obtain the proper liquor licensing for our food & beverage tent. As well the sale and consumption of beer and/or hot spiced wine will be contained within the event area in accordance with the Liquor Control Commission Regulations. We appreciate your support on this matter.

#### SNOWMAN STROLL ARTIST INFORMATION

Downtown Rochester is accepting applications from artists for the Snowman Stroll, a public art event that will bring (12) 5' fiberglass snowmen to Main Street! The Snowman Stroll is open to all artists, whether professional or amateurs. Artists of all ages are encouraged to submit designs.

Artists whose designs are selected by a sponsor will be paid a \$1,000 honorarium.

#### THE DETAILS

#### Specifications

- The Snowman is in a standing pose, 62" in height and 30" in diameter (bottom snowball)
- The material is fiberglass
- The surface is finished so it can be primed and painted
- The snowmen will be placed in the corner gardens along Main Street, from Second Street to University

#### Artist Design Guidelines

- Holiday designs are encouraged, but not required
- Artists can submit up to (2) designs for consideration on the provided snowman sketch
- Artists may paint and adorn the snowman, but the structural integrity of the snowman cannot be compromised.
- All snowmen will be placed outdoors, so a weather resistant sealant is required
- Artists must be available for any touch ups or repairs for the duration of the display
- Artwork CANNOT include political statements, profanity, nudity, logos, QR codes, libel, slander or social disrespect.
- Artists must be able to pick up and transport their snowman to and from Downtown Rochester
- Once an artist submits a design, it becomes the property of the Rochester DDA for use in event marketing, social media and merchandise. If the design is not selected by the committee or a sponsor, the rights to the design will revert to the artist.


