C. Review of Proposed FYE 2023 Budget

Kristi reviewed the draft budget that was presented to City Council on March 28. The Council had no comments on the budget, but was pleased to see that we planned to continue and potentially enhance the Snow Glow Event. Kevin encouraged board members review the budget and to contact Kristi if they had any questions.

D. Farmers' Market Update

Taylor provided an update on the upcoming Farmers' Market Season. Two new vendors will be joining the Market this year – Freeman Meat Co. and Moxie Eats. This year's tote bags have arrived and will be filled with offers/items from downtown merchants and distributed on Opening Day, May 7. Staff is also investigating creating some outdoor health programs, utilizing Heroes Point at the Rochester Fire Department.

5. Reports

A. PSD Financial Report

The current financial report was included in the packet. There were no questions.

B. Events & Marketing

Jenna reported that Deck Art Registration is closing soon and board will begin arriving shortly. Junk in Trunk Registration will begin later this month.

Taylor shared the winning cover design for Spring/Summer Edition of the In Town Magazine from the MOD + Rochester Contest. The winning artist is Tim Gralewski. Magazines are due in homes the week of April 18.

C. Executive Director Report

Kristi reported that Rochester: No Filter will be returning again this year. Last year, the 50 cameras sold out on the first day. This year, a Opening Reception will be held to coincide with the Thursday Night Market on June 9. The exhibition will continue through June 30.

Kristi recapped the DDA's budget presentation to City Council. Highlights included the allocation of funds for Art Downtown and monies set aside for the Front Porch/Town Square.

Kristi shared that City Council did approve placement of the Outdoor Dining Decks for the restaurants again this year. The DDA also requested a waiver of the fees for use of the spaces in light of the monies paid to the Parking Fund by the DDA over the past two years. The vote was 3-3, so the matter will be brought to City Council again at the April 11 Meeting. Kevin shared his frustration with the issue, citing examples of how the restaurants have not fully recovered. Nik suggested that a compromise would be to ask the restaurants to pay the fees. Kristi expressed that for the DDA, it was more a philosophical issue than a financial issue. Many board members indicated that they would be in attendance at the next City Council Meeting to express their viewpoints.

7. Miscellaneous

Kristi shared that there is a date conflict for the May PSD Meeting, as the Just Us Girls Stroll will be using the Studio as their Registration Location. All summer events have been reviewed by the Board over the past two meetings. The Board elected to cancel the May 4 PSD Board Meeting.

Seeing no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:13 pm.
