EXAMPLES

PREPARATION

CANS

Pop, beer, other non-deposit aluminum cans, soup, juice, & pet food cans, pie pans & foil

Rinse out food residue. Labels don't need to be removed. Crushing cans will help conserve space.

GLASS

Wine, liquor, pop, beer or juice bottles, food jars & other clear & colored glass

Remove & dispose of caps. Rinse out residue. Labels don't need to be removed.

PAPER

Newspaper, double-walled cardboard, brown paper bags, white computer paper, gift boxes, junk mail, catalogs, envelopes, color & glossy paper, magazines & phone books

Stack dry papers & place in paper bags. Flatten corrugated boxes no larger than 2 ft. x 3 ft. Staples acceptable, but no paper clips or rubber bands.

PLASTIC

Pop & plastic drink bottles, milk, laundry, & bleach containers, all plastic items up to #7 are acceptable



Rinse all containers. Remove & dispose of lids. Labels don't need to be removed. Crushing containers conserve space.

METAL

Pipes & gutters

Acceptable if clean & cut into pieces no more than 2 ft. x 3 ft. long, tied & bundled, put in a box or neatly contained.

OFF LIMITS

Paper milk or juice cartons, styrofoam containers/packing, garbage, propane tanks, paint cans, medical waste, flammable liquids, household cleaners, chemicals (dry or liquid), wood items, wax-coated paperboard or cardboard

WHERE TO RECYCLE

- 400 block West Alley (behind Mr. B's Restaurant)
- 400 block West Alley
- 400 block West Alley (behind Rojo Mexican Bistro)
- 300 block West Alley
- 200 block West Alley
- 400 block West Alley
- E. University (behind Century 21 Sakmar)

Each trash enclosure contains three 96-gallon recycle bins outside the enclosure area.

For larger items, please use the green recycling dumpsters placed inside each enclosure area. (The green dumpsters are for recycling only; the red dumpsters are for trash disposal.)
